Double Blessing!

Dear Parents,

I am so encouraged by your attendance and response to our recent "State of the School" meetings! Your comments indicate a desire to do whatever it takes to ensure the viability of Christian Chapel Academy, now and into the future. We have a great school, and you have demonstrated your love and appreciation for all the blessings your family receives here. I look forward to your continued involvement as we work together in unity to build the "wall of sustainability" around CCA, following the biblical example of Nehemiah building the wall around Jerusalem.

The first step in building sustainability for our school is to support our tuition assistance awards through contributions and fund-raising events. Our goal for these efforts is \$40,000—the amount we have already approved for the current school year.

- **Contributions.** A matching challenge has been issued by one of our dedicated parents to fund tuition assistance! Every dollar you contribute to tuition assistance by December 31 will be matched, dollar for dollar, up to a limit of \$2,000! Double the value of your gift by participating in this matching challenge! Let's raise the first \$4,000 of our \$40,000 goal by December 31.
- **Fund-raising events.** Many of you have shared good ideas for fund-raising projects, and I appreciate your enthusiasm. Tim Glass and I are gathering a team to consider all your suggestions and develop a coordinated plan to enhance our effectiveness. We will be sharing definite plans in January, 2012. The proceeds of all our fund-raising efforts will go toward our tuition assistance goal of \$40,000.

During our State of the School meeting, I asked you to consider donating to CCA any portion of the tuition discount or assistance that you have received during this school year.
