\*\*All CCA families with students enrolled will be required to earn ten (10) service hours per school year (August-May). The requirement is per family, not per student. Ten (10) hours will be required regardless of the number of children enrolled. Our goal is to be as flexible as we can with opportunities to serve. We will have opportunities not only during the regular school day, but also in the evenings, and on some weekends to accommodate a variety of schedules. There will be a buy-out option for those families who choose not to serve these hours. FSA hours are valued at \$10 per hour. Therefore, the buy-out option would be \$100 per family per school year.
